- I. What is Jesus Lord of?
 - A. Jesus was with God in creation
 - B. Jesus is Lord of all He created
 - C. Jesus is Lord of life
 - D. God has given Him a kingdom that will be forever
 - E. Every knee shall bow to Jesus the King of Kings

- II. How much of your life is Jesus Lord of?
 - A. The kingdom of God is to be within each of us for now
 - B. One day the kingdom will be consummated in eternity
 - C. To honor the King we must take our cross and deny ourselves
 - D. The servant is not greater than his Master; we will suffer
 - E. Jesus is the vine we are the branches which must produce fruit
 - F. Jesus reminds us that without Him we can do nothing
 - G. How much of our life is; “I will do all I can and then ask the Lord to help when I get in trouble?”
 - H. We need to be like the apostles this day to realize that Jesus is Lord of All

- III. The apostles were reprimanded because of their lack of faith.
 - A. First for thinking that the Lord did not care for them.
 - B. Second that the Lord did not have the power in the everyday affairs of life
 1. Some in Biblical times did not – Disciples praying for Peter and John – Jarius praying for his daughter
 2. Are we not guilty of thinking – God doesn’t care – God does not take care of things like this
 - C. We need to realize Jesus is Lord of All in our world.
