- I. Angels appeared to the shepherds and proclaimed
 - A. Glad Tidings
 - B. Great Joy
 - C. To All People
 - D. A Savior Is Born
 1. More than just a baby
 2. He is Christ (the anointed of God)
 3. The Lord (He is God)
 - a. Mary told He is to be conceived of the Holy Ghost
 - b. Mary told He shall be called the Son of the Highest
 - c. He is a king and His kingdom is eternal
 4. Men need this Savior
 - a. Separated from a Holy God
 - b. Cannot saved themselves
 - c. Christ alone can reconcile men to God
